### ***What is Newday like?***

***Newday is a place where*** young people (aged 12-19) can explore the big questions of life in a low pressure setting. *There's a whole load of fun, hanging out with new friends, relaxing, listening to teaching, live music and playing sports. Its a real highlight of the year, making memories you will never forget!*

***Who is going?*** Loads of young people and a few others from Kings Church. We take an Elder & a fantastic team of leaders & caterers.

***Camp*** – Yes that does mean sleeping in tents, which **you will need to provide.**

If you are providing a tent, please have the bag named with clear instructions attached for putting it up. A few days before the event starts, tents and bedding will be collected down at the centre and loaded onto a van. Dropping off times will be announced at the parents meeting. It is your responsibility to make sure your tent is fit for purpose, it's complete, it's waterproof, and that you can take it down.

***Toilets*** – It's camping (but don't worry, they will flush!) Do bring your own roll of toilet paper and a torch for any night time dash to the toilet. It may be a little walk.

**Showers** – Sometimes hot, sometimes cold. Bring a large plastic bag to shove your clothes in while you shower as the cubicle floor may be wet.

**Phones**- Phones are your responsibility however we do have charging facilities in our marquee.

**Food** - All meals (all totally fantastic) are provided and eaten together in our marquee. All you have to do is to turn up on time, eat up, enjoy and then wash up – simple! Your plates etc will be put together at the beginning of the week so make sure they are clearly labelled with paint/nail varnish so you can reclaim them at the end. **DO NOT BRING PAPER PLATES!** If you do have any special dietary requirements please put full details on the booking form. If you don't put it on the form you will be expected to eat what is provided for everyone else.

#### ***Will there be any chance to spend any money?***

There will be many opportunities to spend money such as in the bookshop and cafes. However we do not recommend taking loads of money as we cannot guarantee its safekeeping. The same goes for all personal belongings. Please make sure that you are covered by your home contents insurance as we cannot be held responsible for any items that go 'missing'.

#### ***Skateboards?***

No cycling, rollerblading, scooter, skateboarding etc is allowed on site at Newday.

To ensure Newday is as safe as possible skateboarding is restricted to the skate park and only when the skate park team are in attendance to supervise.

**So please don't bring bikes etc with you to Newday.** All people using the skate park at *Newday* will be required to sign a disclaimer, and wear a bash hat. We will have a limited supply of helmets available to borrow, but to be sure of getting use of the park as often as possible, please bring your own if you have one. Cycle helmets do not count! They must be proper skate helmets."

#### ***Wristbands***

These will be issued at the start of the event and must be worn **at all times**. There maybe a penalty fee for replacement wrist bands so they need to be taken care of.

#### ***Emergencies***

Details of how to contact us when at Newday will be given out at the parents meeting.

### ***Parents meeting***

This will be on **Sunday 23<sup>rd</sup> July 2017** at the Kings Centre. You will get to hear about the practical arrangements and have the chance to ask questions. It is really helpful if all parents attend this meeting. If you are unable to, please endeavour to send a representative. If you attend Kings Seaford or Centro sorry but you will need to come to the Kings Centre for the meeting.

### ***Attendance and behaviour.***

As leaders we are very aware of our responsibility to ensure the safety and well being of everyone on site at Newday. There are various rules and guidelines that must be followed and they are included in the behaviour agreement. Please read the behaviour agreement carefully (at the end of this document), it needs to be signed by youth & their parent/guardian (even if 18). We will send home anyone who fails keep his or her behaviour agreement at the expense of his or her parents/guardians. We also reserve the right to refuse attendance at Newday if an individual's behaviour has been unacceptable in the weeks running up to the event.

## ***... and a bit more information for parents ...***

**All leaders** are police checked (DBS) and will receive refresher training prior to the event including child protection training, which as a church we take very seriously.

### ***Travel***

We will travel by coach. Please let us know if you get suffer from travel sickness.

### ***Medical info***

There is a full medical team on site, but we will also have qualified first aiders amongst our own leaders. If your child/ward is taking medication, a responsible adult can administer it if necessary. All medication taken will need to be recorded on the Booking/Consent Form, even if being self administered.

### ***Outreach into Norwich***

There will be the opportunity to leave the site and take part in various projects organised by 'Newday', in and around Norwich. A competent leader will lead these and there will be one of our leaders with every 6 of our youth. Old clothes and 'sensible' shoes will be needed for the social action projects and long trousers may be required. A parental/guardian signature is required on the Consent Form if you wish to go out on outreach/street evangelism/social action.

### ***Care***

Each leader will be responsible for 6 youth. This does not mean that they stay with them for the whole day but it does mean that someone is keeping an eye out for your child/ward to make sure that everything is going well for them. The adult to youth ratio will be at least 1:6. We also have a wonderful catering team who will always give them warm welcome as they return from the activities of the day.

### ***Cost:***

This year there is only one price break date of the **4<sup>th</sup> April 2017**. If you book after this date the cost is **£20** more, so book early. A deposit of **£30** is required at the time of booking. You can pay the

balance in instalments or the whole lot in one go. Final payments must be made by **Friday 14th of July**

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## Newday Behaviour Agreement

1. I will treat all leaders and other young people and property with respect. I will not do anything that brings dishonour on my parents, friends or the church.
2. I will follow the instructions that leaders give me. As it is their responsibility to look after my well being, I will co-operate wholeheartedly with the leaders to make their responsibility for me a pleasure!
3. I will take all sensible precautions to protect others and myself from harm, including wearing my seatbelt at all times while on a coach.
4. I will talk to my allocated leader as soon as I have any problems, medical issues or relationship difficulties.
5. I will attend every morning and evening meeting. I will have a positive attitude and will encourage others to do the same. I will also turn up promptly for all meals, unless prearranged with a leader.
6. I will comply with the Newday site rules, including the curfews, staying on site unless on a social action project accompanied by a leader, not bringing drugs, alcohol or cigarettes onto the site nor use them, nor do anything that breaks the law.
7. I understand that no one of the opposite sex is allowed in my tent. Matches, gas, meths or solid fuel stoves or lights are also not allowed in or around tents.
8. I am aware that if another youth group or the Newday organisers complain about me I can be sent straight home.

There will be a yellow and red card system in place. You will first be issued a Verbal Warning for your first offence this is exactly what it says on the tin, then for your second offence you will be issued with a yellow card (this means you will be on chores for the day and you are well in line for doughnut of the day). If another yellow card has to be issued it becomes a red card and you will be sent home. The Card system re sets each day, but consistent breaking of the same rule will result in a Red Card. The leaders reserve the right to immediately red card and send you home if they feel your behaviour is seriously inappropriate.
